Lessons from the Mission Field (Part 2) Matthew 20:25-28

What makes you mad? Most people get angry when they feel like they have been treated unfairly or when they are criticized. What made the 10 disciples mad?

"And when the ten heard it, they were moved with indignation against the two brethren." Matthew 20:24

What did James and John do? They just asked, "Jesus, can we sit on your right hand and left hand in your kingdom? We just want the highest place of honor, fame, and ______ in the kingdom!" The 10 disciples were so mad because that's what they wanted too - power and honor!

Jesus didn't lose His temper over their selfish request. He just patiently taught them an incredible truth about extravagant service.

Jesus taught them...

- 1) Unbelieving Gentiles exercise authority with force, v. 25.
- 2) You will not act like the unbelieving Gentiles, v. 26.
- 3) You will be a servant a minister, v. 26b-27.
- 4) I want you to follow My example, v. 28.

What does it mean to serve?

It means to give of your time, your energy, your money, and your gifts to help someone else. Serving others is how we share the love of Jesus. Every Christian is to serve God in their local church but also look for opportunities to serve outside the walls of our church building. The Bible makes it clear that, when a person is in a real relationship with God, he or she will serve God. We want to serve God because we love Him, Romans 8:29.

"I have given you an example that ye should do as I have done to you," John 13:15.
