4. How to Get an Advantage over Satan
A. Seek God, v. 8 "Be Sober
Make your body your servant, not your master. Your heart and soul are to tell your mind and body what to do.
B. Be Alert to Spiritual Danger, v. 8 "be vigilant."
v. 8 – Peter likens Satan to a roaring lion whose purpose is to devour and destroy you.
C. Understand your Authority, v. 8.
Pride makes believers spiritually careless. Humility keeps us dependent on God's strength, Jude 9.
D Temptation, v. 9a.
"There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." I Corinthians 10:13
E. Put on the Armor of God, v. 9b, Ephesians 6:10-19.
F. Grow Deep Spiritual Roots, v. 10.
1) Equip Yourself with Scripture
2) Pray Regularly "Pray without ceasing." I Thess. 5:17
G God, v. 17.
If you're having a bad day, start praising God for who He is and what He has done.
H. Worship and Serve God at Church Consistently, v. 12-14.
Isolation makes you weak. Fellowship with believers makes you strong.
Spiritual warfare is not dramatic, it is Walk in God's truth.
